WOLF HOUSE

420 SE WATULA AVE, OCALA, FL 34471

This Frame Vernacular style home was built in 1913. It is named the "Wolf House" after William and Sallie Wolf, the first owners. The 3,400 sq. foot structure cost \$4,000 to build.

The home served as a boarding home during the 1930's and 1940's. In 1977, the City of Ocala purchased it for use as office space, and it housed the Ocala Marion Transportation Planning Organization.

In 2019, the house was donated to Ambleside school. The building was moved 700 feet down Watula Avenue from the corner of Southeast 2nd Street and Watula Avenue to its present location. The house now serves as the Ambleside High School.
