The Hub was a clothing store built in 1953. It was owned and operated by Robert "Bob" Leibowitz, a member of the Ocala City Council, and had been serving local customers since 1953.

It is now the home of the Brick City Center for the Arts and the Marion Cultural Alliance. Ironically, it is now serving as a "hub" for all arts in the Ocala community.
